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**RESOURCE MOBILIZATION POLICY AND
PROCEDURE FOR OPTIMUM UTILIZATION OF
RESOURCESS**

Currently, the College's primary sources of funds include donations, corpus donations, tuition fees from students, outpatient treatment charges, and hostel rent. The yearly budgeting is carried out under the direct supervision of the Chairman. During the early stages of the College's establishment, when building construction and the acquisition of dental equipment were necessary, the main sources of funding were bank loans, corpus donations from trustees, and donations from well-wishers. Over time, as major construction work and equipment acquisition were completed, the funds now mainly cover recurring expenses such as salaries, maintenance costs, loan repayments, and dental consumables. The tuition fees have increased over the years, and there has also been a rise in outpatient numbers. The College is making every effort to provide the best facilities for patients, thereby increasing the treatment charges collected. With the completion of major infrastructure projects, the level of corpus donations has decreased.

Using the available funds from donations, tuition fees, outpatient collections, hostel rent, etc., the College strives to offer world-class facilities to students. The best dental consumables are provided for students' practical work, and experienced teaching staff are appointed to ensure quality education. Each year, additional books are purchased for the UG/PG library, and the latest editions of e-journals are added. The College building and hostel facilities are consistently maintained to high standards, with regular repairs and maintenance carried out. Furthermore, all dental equipment, furniture, and other facilities such as air conditioning, televisions, and electrical fittings are regularly repaired and maintained, with annual maintenance contracts (AMCs) provided where necessary.
